**Psalm 136:1 says "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good. His love endures forever".**

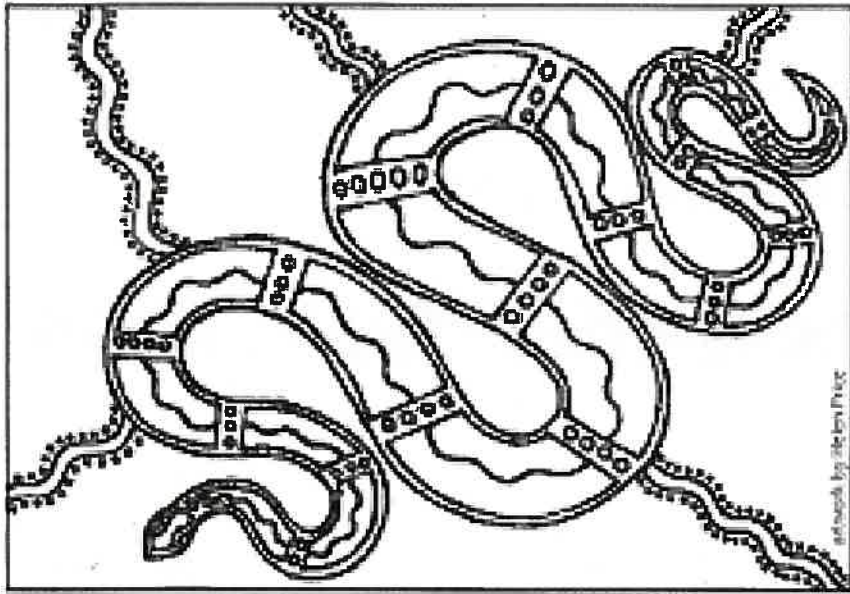
God's goodness is the foundation for us all that he works all things together for our good, even in our struggles or weakness or worries he is there for us, helping us and comforting us.

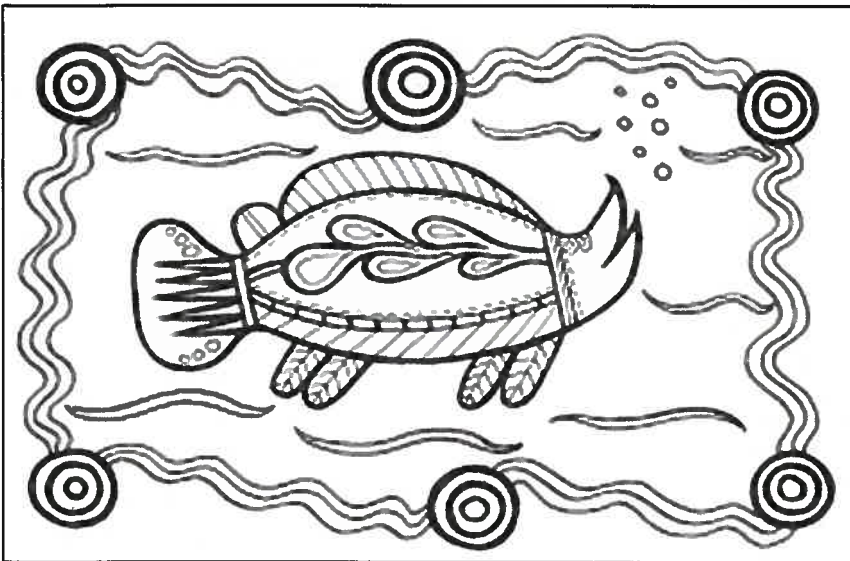
Have a refreshing and blessed holiday filled with His enduring love.
