A Message from the Director of School Campus



Dear Families

I'd like to share some of the most recent information with you as the COVID journey continues.

If you test positive for COVID-19, you must stay at home for 7 full days from your test date. After a week in isolation, you can leave and return to school if you don't have any new symptoms and a dry cough.

If you are a close contact, you must wear a face mask outside of your home for the next 7 days, including indoors and outdoors, if you are unable to physically distance yourself from people (other than members of your household). If you are a close contact and need to leave home, it is recommended that you undertake regular testing (such as on day 0, 2, 4, 6). Close contacts are permitted to attend school, but **children over 12 must wear a face mask**. Children under 12 do not have to wear masks but are encouraged to do so.

Premier Annastacia Palaszczuk has strongly advised wearing face masks indoors to help limit the spread of the current wave of COVID-19.

I thank everyone for their support in keeping our school community safe. I appreciate you informing us if your child or a family member tested positive for COVID-19. Our teachers will arrange for work to be sent home for children in isolation so that learning is not disrupted. I will continue to send letters home to inform you of positive cases at school.


